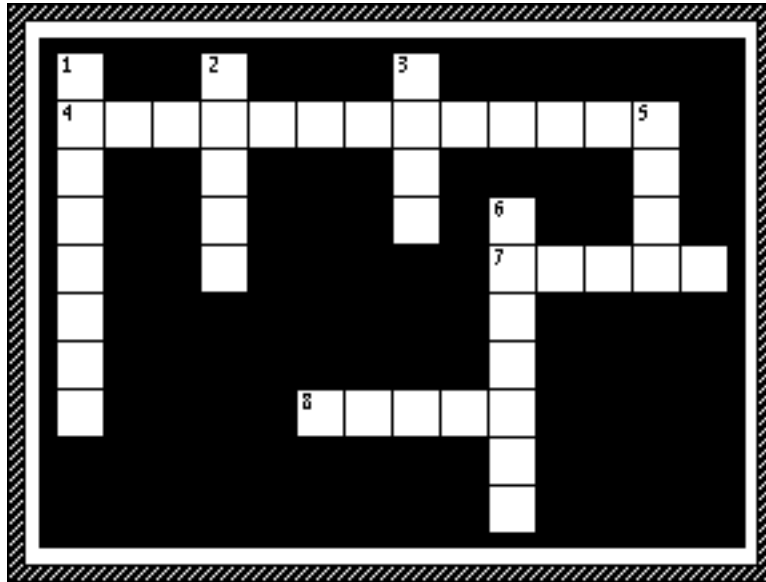

- 3 DOWN Finally, the LORD said, "So if you \_\_\_\_\_ in My ways, to keep My statutes and My commandments, as your father David walked, then I will lengthen your days." **1 KINGS 3:14**

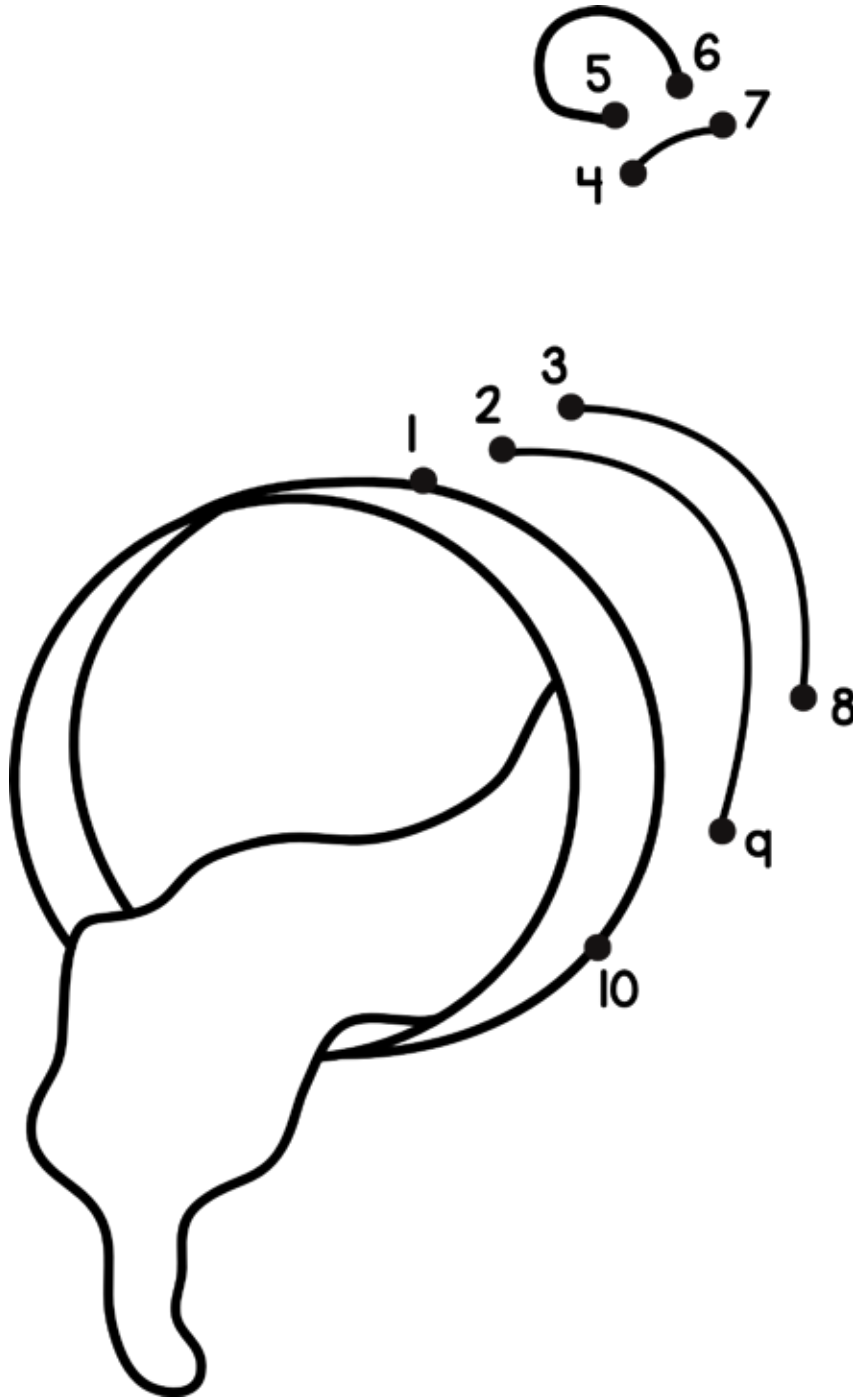
