Discussion Questions

1.  - What are some ways we can do this individually and corporately?
 - Who do you want to see rescued and redeemed?
3. In my heart, have I made an idol of “being churchy” rather than truly worshiping God?
4. What am I seeking when I gather with the saints?
5. What is occupying my attention? How much “airtime” am I devoting to the things of God in my thought life?
6. Is my response to all of God’s attributes one of repentance and obedience?
7. How am I using my time, talents and treasure to extol God?
8. Have I allowed my time of worshiping together to become rote or routine?
